



Why Update the General Plan Now?

- City's last comprehensive update was in 2012
- Will set a new vision for San Marcos; affirm values and priorities while connecting with the community
- Address current opportunities, challenges, and trends
- Address State legislative changes on how San Marcos must address housing, mobility, environmental justice, and climate change/resiliency
- Housing Element must be adopted by 2021 to comply with State law



What is a General Plan?



Documents the future vision of the community



Includes goals and policies whereby land use and other critical decisions are made



Establishes the roadmap for future economic vitality, development, and resource management



Ensures all decisions are consistent with the community vision

Housing Element



- Current Housing Element effective through 2021
- 2021-2029 Housing Element must be adopted by April 2021



- Ongoing effort to increase State oversight and control of local governments
- Significant amount of legislation since 2017, mostly related to:
 - Local Accountability
 - Streamlining
 - Funding






Housing (2013-2021)

GPAC Role

- General Plan Advisory Committee (GPAC)
- Mission -
 - Assist the General Plan project team by:
 - Engaging the community stakeholders in the update process members are considered community liaisons and project ambassadors;
 - Listening to and considering community ideas and input;
 - Evaluating alternative approaches;
 - Making recommendations on high level vision, goals, and policies;
 - Review and provide input on land use alternatives.
 - Attend GPAC meetings
 - Attend public workshops



GPAC Commitment



Project is expected to take approximately 2 years



Monthly meetings, public workshops, community outreach events



While interacting with others in the community, the GPAC should:

- Communicate the intent of the General Plan Update
- Identify community priorities & values
- Gather ideas and community issues, convey during the process


