Support for the new land use ideas, including transitional designations, to allow more flexibility for property owners	
Concurrence with Staff's recommendation to maintain the Current GP designation (VLDR) for the Briggs property	
The development pattern and potential growth allowed under Alternative 1 more closely represents the community's vision (versus Alternative 2)	
 Parts of changes included in Alternative 2 might still be appropriate (around the Civic Center) at more focused locations
